## Parents, Carers & School Contract

Partnership is at the heart of our work. We honour parents and carers as the children's first educators, knowing that children learn better when the school and family work in partnership.

We value the well-being of all who work at, play in and visit Rosemary. We recognise that children learn from and imitate the ways in which adults behave around them.

As staff and governors, we will ensure that our interactions are respectful: For example, all children and families are welcomed on arrival at the setting, ensuring that the first contact of the day is positive.

We ask that parents and carers are also respectful in the way that they interact with us and with each other. In particular,

### **We expect all parents, carers and visitors to the school to:**

- Set a good example in your own speech and behaviour towards all members of the school community. This means not swearing or using bad language, speaking when you are spoken to and using a respectful tone.
- Work together with staff and governors for the benefit of children. This includes approaching the school directly to resolve any issues of concern.
- Reinforce the school's policy on Behaviour – please see the [Behaviour Policy](#).
- Park with consideration for our neighbours and children's safety when dropping off and collecting children from school.
- Keep dogs on a lead and secured away from the main school entrance.

### **The school will not tolerate:**

- Disruptive behaviour which interferes with the smooth running of any curriculum activity, either in the Nursery or outside, including Forest School and other educational visits, or any office area or other part of the school grounds.
- The use of loud and/or offensive language.
- Threatening or causing harm or physical aggression towards another adult or child.
- Abusive, threatening, malicious or inflammatory emails, phone or social network messages
